This week in **Maths** Reception have learnt how to count to four and write the number too!




Year 1 were very excited to have THE Goldilocks come visit us on Wednesday. The children thought of and asked her some brilliant questions and found out lots more about the character.




Year 2 enjoyed bouncing in the 'Bounce-a-thon' this week.



Shoebox Appeal Can you help?

Each class will be responsible for filling two shoeboxes to support this year's shoebox appeal. The shoeboxes will be going to families in Romania, Moldova, Ukraine and Bulgaria, who are poor and marginalised. They will receive them just before Christmas!

The items required to go in the shoeboxes are.

Each box should have

Gloves/scarf or hat. Sweets/chocolates (Best before June 2020)
Soap and flannel. Toothbrush/toothpaste. Candles and holders.
Small games (travel size drafts/dominoes playing cards)

Then at least 5 of the remaining items.

Colouring pads (A5) crayons/pencils (with rubber and sharpener)
small toys (yo-yo, skipping rope, toy cars) soft toy/ (with CE label)
tape measure/DIY tool. Headscarf (lightweight) shampoo (Max 300 ml) solar-powered calculator. Safety razors.

The boxes need to be filled by the 25 October 2019
