Think deeply about...

- Can you tell me your favourite story?
- Do you have a special teddy bear?
- Where did the family go on their bear hunt?
- Where would you go on your bear hunt?

Learn...

- To listen to different stories about bears.
- To begin to be able to retell the key parts of stories and join in repeated phrases.
- To make / colour in maps of the bears journey.
- To begin to make believe using small world toys.

Use...

- Bear - Brown bear
- Snowstorm - heavy snow blowing in the wind.
- River - wide stretch of water.
- Cave - a dark hole in a rock.
- Hunt - to look for something.



Explore

What was your favourite bear story?

Go on a bear hunt - pretend to go to the different places, acting out walking through the swishy swashy grass, twirl in the whirling swirling snowstorm, squelch squerch through the mud, stumble trip through the forest and tiptoe in the deep dark cave.
