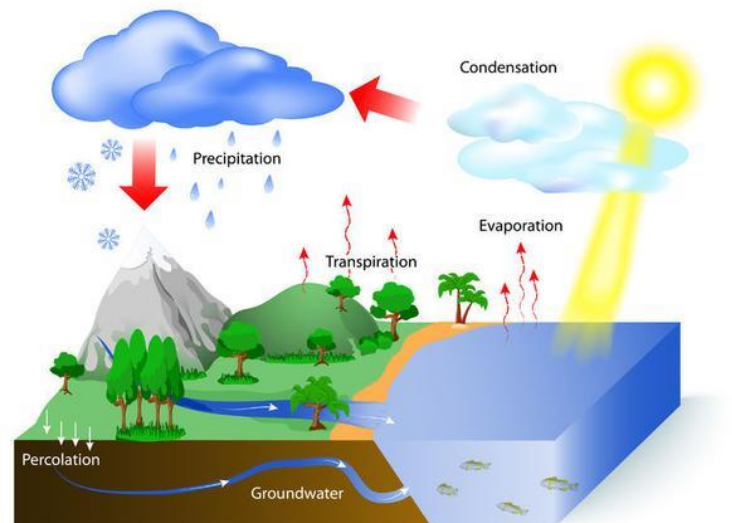
- What can we learn about life around the river from John Crome's paintings?
