## Think deeply about...

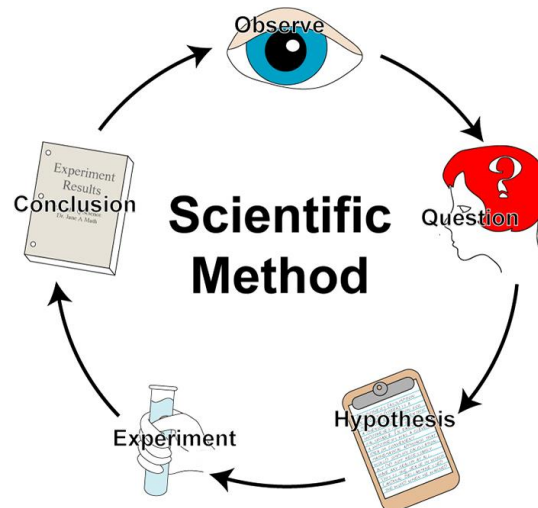
- What questions can I ask about the world around me?
