### Use...

Spring, Easter

Job, money, police officer, teacher, hairdresser, artist, firefighter, doctor, builder, nurse, paramedic

**Maths:**

Numbers 0-20.

2D Shapes: Circle, rectangle, square, triangle, pentagon,

3D Shapes: cuboid, cube, sphere, cylinder, pyramid, cone,

Vertices, side, face, apex

Addition, subtraction, is equal to, add, take away.

- Practise singing the Easter song
