Think deeply about...

- What different types of transport there are.
- How different vehicles move - on land, on water or in the air.
- How different vehicles move - wheels, propellers, engines, human or animal power.
- What different vehicles have you travelled on?

Learn...

- The know the names of different common vehicles.
- To look carefully at vehicles to help you decide where and how they travel.
- To sort vehicles based on how they travel - land, air or water.
- To look at how different vehicles are used to help us e.g. tractors, diggers, ambulances.
- Learn the story The Journey Home from Grandpas.
- To look at what transport we have in our local area.

Use...

- Car, Lorry, truck, train, helicopter, aeroplane, digger, tractor, bicycle, bus.
- Ticket - to allow you to travel.
- Fare -how much it costs to travel.
- Wheels /tyres -round parts of a vehicle that allows it to move easily.
- Propellers - blades that move in circle on a helicopter or aeroplane.
