Working As One.




Nursery have been making salt dough hedgehogs, making snips with scissors to make spikes.

This week Year 1 have been investigating schools from 'then and now'. We have talked about similarities and differences.




This week Year 2 have been making bread like Thomas Farriner in the Great Fire of London.
