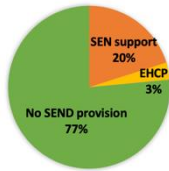
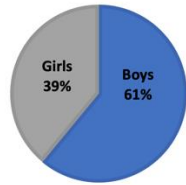

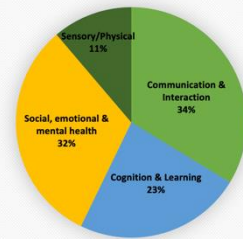


GENDER WITH IDENTIFIED SEND

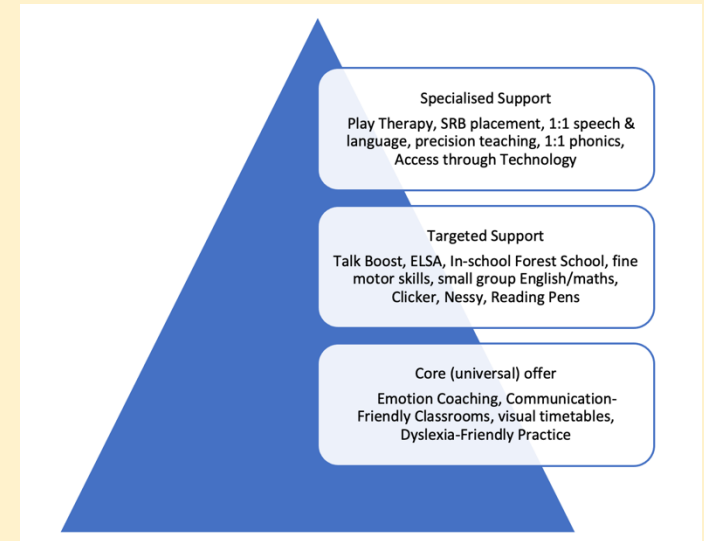

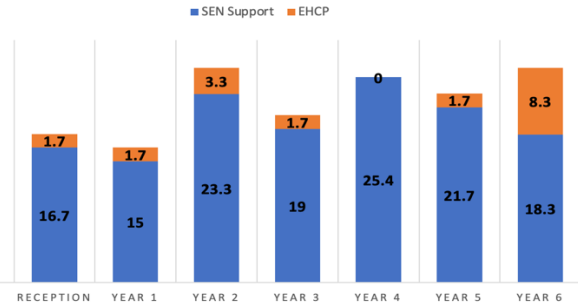
% OF SEN BY BROAD AREA OF NEED

% WITH SEN BY YEAR GROUP



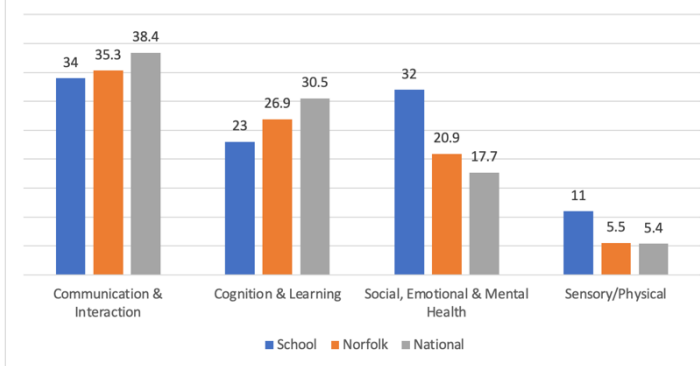
